Barriers to achievement

Barriers to achievement in our school typically are:

- **Less time spent at Early Years provision to secure school readiness**
- **Inability to access home learning**
- **Reduced access to resources at home**
- **Less able to afford school uniform and sports kit**
- **Reduced access to one to one time with an adult**
- **Less opportunity for enrichment visits**
- **Less access to transport to enrich the curriculum**
- **Less time to practise skills at home**
- **Poor attendance parents' poor perception of school based own school experiences**
