



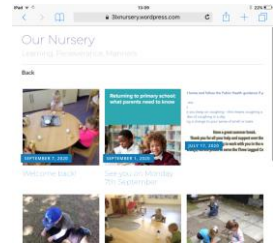
Butterflies Newsletter

What your child needs

Please ensure all of your child's clothing is named. Children are encouraged to be independent, but mistakes can happen. Please check clothing and uniform at home to confirm ownership.

Please ensure your child has a change of clothes (including underwear and socks), nappies and wipes (if needed), warm clothing, waterproof coat, waterproof trousers, and wellington boots (we regularly go into the forest where it is often muddy). We use sensitive skin wet wipes at nursery for messy times. If you prefer us not to use these on your child, please inform a member of staff. Thank you.

Arrival and collection

Morning sessions will be 8.50am until 11.50am and afternoon sessions will be 11.50am until 2.50pm. A full day session will be 8.50am until 2.50pm. Nursery children are also welcome to attend our breakfast and after school clubs. Our staff will meet you at the front gate for drop off. If you have a sibling, the earlier drop offs will continue at the youngest school age siblings allocated drop off time. We will bring your child to the gate at the appropriate time for leaving.
