




Peacock Newsletter

This will usually be an active task to reinforce and consolidate learning, often involving discussion and practical challenges, designed to be easily carried out within your home environment. The children will also bring home a reading book to share with you and it would be great if you could write a comment in their blue reading record. Initially, these books are likely to contain illustrations only for you and your child to chat about together, until they become confident to read a range of graphemes (a written letter) and know the phoneme (the sound it makes). All children will read with adults in school on an individual basis at least weekly.
