will go on the class blog. This will usually be an active task to reinforce and consolidate learning, often involving discussion and practical challenges designed to be easily carried out within your home environment. The children will also bring home a reading book to share with you. Initially, these books are likely to contain illustrations only for you and your child to chat about together, until they become confident to read a range of graphemes (a written letter) and know the phoneme (the sound it makes). All children will read with adults in school on an individual basis at least weekly.

Please log your child's reading using the Boom Reader (previously known as Go Read) app. More details about this will follow shortly.

Be prepared!

The children will enjoy a wide range of fun and exciting learning opportunities, both indoors and outdoors. As the weather changes, please ensure your child has a named waterproof coat, waterproof trousers, and wellington boots to continue enjoying our range of outdoor learning areas daily. We will also have two sessions of PE weekly, so please check your child has a named PE kit in school at all times. We encourage children to be independent when changing, so clearly named clothes are vital to help this go as smoothly as possible. Thanks for your help and understanding!
